What does Tevilah (immersion) and the Mikvah (pool of living water) symbolize?

- It is a symbolic act of being washed clean and being set free from the past life and sins and changing from the past masters whom you served to serve only the One true God of Israel!
- It is the renouncing of the kingdom of this world and haSatan and self-sovereignty.
- It represents dying to the lower selfish nature and ego.
- It is a spiritual process which symbolized a change from tamei (unclean) to tahor (pure).
- It is a commitment to burying the "old man" and coming out to walk in the "newness of life".
- It is the acceptance of citizenship in the kingdom of YHVH Eloheinu.
- It is the personal commitment to take on all the responsibilities of being a citizen of the kingdom of YHVH Eloheinu.

- 4. Do you of your own free will choose to be a citizen in the kingdom of YHVH Eloheinu?

- 5. Do you have your own free will choose to submit yourself completely to the rulership and authority of YHVH Eloheinu?
 - A: Of my own free will, I choose to submit myself completely to the rulership and authority of YHVH Eloheinu
- 6. Do you of your own free will commit to take on all responsibilities of being a citizen of the kingdom of YHVH Elohim and to strive to live by Torah, the teachings and instructions of YHVH?
 - A: Of my own free will, I commit to taking on all responsibilities of being a citizen of the kingdom of YHVH Elohim and to strive to live by Torah, the teachings and instructions of YHVH?
- 7. Do you of your own free will request that YHVH annul any and all previous agreements with any and all other organizations and authorities that you have made that are in conflict with Him?

- 8. And do you of your own free will choose to take upon yourself the name of YHVH as His child and a member of the family of Israel and to commit to walk out the rest of your life in such a way as to bring the name glory and honor and not shame?
